Terms & Conditions

*It is a requirement of the form that you have read and agree to the Terms and Conditions outlined below.

- 1. The Shark Deterrent Rebate (Rebate) is available to Western Australian residents who provide proof of a Western Australian residential address and comply with the requirements of these Terms & Conditions.
- 2. Maximum of one Rebate per person per device. The rebate can only be applied to one RPELA purchase per person, that is either the Complete RPELA Kit or RPELA Unit Device Only.
- 3. The offer is available for approved shark deterrent devices.
- 4. The offer is only valid for new shark deterrent devices.
- 5. The offer is not valid for:
 - a. accessories (e.g. carry bags and chargers);
 - b. extended warranties (if purchased separately); and
 - c. refurbishments.
- 6. The Rebate can only be claimed by registered retailers. A list of registered retailers can be found at www.sharksmart.com.au/staying-safe/rebate
- 7. All Rebate claims must be made by submitting the online application form at https://rebate.fish.wa.gov.au/. No postal, facsimilies or emailed refund requests will be accepted.
- 8. Proof of Western Australian residence must be included with the application and may include a current:
 - a. Western Australian driver's licence or learner's permit.
 - b. Western Australian recreational fishing licence.
 - c. Medicare card in combination with a utility bill e.g. telephone, gas, electricity, water (not more than 3 months old).
 - d. Persons under the age of 18 may also use:
 - i. Student ID card.
 - ii. A combination of their parent/guardian driver's licence and Medicare card (which includes reference to their name).
- 9. The \$200 rebate must be applied by the retailer at the point of sale and appear on the tax invoice.
- 10. A tax invoice must be provided clearly showing the retail outlet, product information, retail price, \$200 rebate applied and date of purchase
- 11. The Rebate will be delivered in the form of an Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) into the retailer's nominated Australian bank account. Applications will be processed within 30 days of submission.
- 12. The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development reserves the right to verify the validity of all claims.
- 13. The Department of Primary Industries and Regional Development will provide a minimum of 14 days' notice to all registered retailers when the Rebate scheme is to end.
- 14. The Western Australian Government is responsible solely for administering the rebate, and assumes no liability for the manufacture or operation of the approved shark deterrent device, or the users' activities. The Western Australian Government advises that the approved shark deterrent device cannot provide a guarantee against shark interactions, and encourages all water-users to take personal responsibility for their actions, including checking all available information before entering the water.
