Important Notes:

Under section 141 of the Fish Resources Management Act 1994 entitlement under an authorisation may, in certain circumstances, be transferred to another authorisation.

Where a security interest is noted on the register against an authorisation, then a section 141 application may only be given immediate effect where the security holder has given consent to the temporary transfer of entitlement.

The Department is implementing an on-line system to enable applications for the temporary transfer of entitlement to be made electronically. Written applications will still be able to be made in the usual way by use of the 'T3' approved form.

The on-line system must accommodate the consent of any security interest holder, where that consent has been given.

One means of giving consent to the temporary transfer of entitlement is by executing this form, so as to provide enduring consent to any application for the temporary transfer of entitlement (whether made on-line or otherwise).

Where enduring consent is given by means of executing this form, then that consent may be withdrawn by the security holder giving further notice in writing to the Department. However the security holder must acknowledge that by giving their enduring consent, then they authorise the Department to act on that consent until both (a) the security holder has given written notice revoking the consent <u>and</u> (b) the Department has given effect to that notice of revocation in the Department's internal administrative and on-line systems.

Before providing enduring consent by executing this form, a security holder is advised to consider both (a) the above information and (b) whether they ought to seek independent legal advice.
